The latest figures released by the government reveal 120 families were identified as being in need of intervention in Tower Hamlets - the highest figure in the 32 London boroughs.

Of these families, all have been officially 'turned around', meaning children are now regularly attending school and parents are back in work and adults and/or children are no longer involved in crime or anti-social behaviour.

The council addresses the problems by assigning a professional to work closely with the family.

The worker will then liaise with agencies who are involved with the family, accompany adults to meetings at school about truancy or poor attendance, offer support to help them understand the importance of school and education, as well as helping parents write CVs and look for work.

Party ban at estate where man died

GREENWICH council confirmed it had taken action to ban parties at an industrial estate.

A Greenwich council spokesman said: "Following a number of complaints received about disruption and noise to residents caused by unlicensed events and activities at Lyndon Industrial Estate in Abbey Wood, the Royal Borough has taken action to ban parties, events and church services at the site operating illegally."

"We are grateful to those who have reported the noise and can attract vandals or squatters."

House abandoned for 20 years back in use

A HOUSE which stood derelict for two decades has finally been restored after a council took legal action against the owners.

Greenwich council served a notice forcing the owner to sell the property, in response to complaints from nearby residents.

Councillor Chris Kirby, the borough's cabinet member for housing, said: "There were complex legal issues here and we supported and advised the owner throughout the process, trying to get the best for all involved. Empty properties can be an eyesore and can attract vandals or squatters."

Community partnership boost for Gardens

LOCAL people are welcome to an event to mark the completion of the first phase of improvements to Rockliffe Gardens this Saturday (July 4).

It's the royal borough's official re-opening of the beautiful green space in Plumstead. The free event, celebrates the success of a fruitful partnership between the council and the local community who have worked together to establish the Friends of Rockliffe Gardens group.

Workers on a special council jobs scheme have also been heavily involved. The 'HILL' (Highways Improvement Local Labour) scheme has been set up by the council to provide work for unemployed residents to make improvements to local roads and open spaces.

It means they can get valuable skills and training, while the council can deliver improvements above and beyond the scheduled maintenance programme.

HILL is part of Greenwich Local Labour and Business (GLLB), the council's job service which matches local people with local job and training vacancies and apprenticeships.

The HILL workers teamed up with construction company Blaney to re-pave part of the Gardens to the first stage of the improvements - with further work planned in the near future. A significant amount of pruning and tidying up has also been undertaken by the council to help make the Gardens a beautiful place for local residents to enjoy.

The launch event runs from 1.30pm to 3pm in the Gardens off Camdale Road in Plumstead. During the afternoon there will be information on the interesting history of the gardens and future improvement works.
